Indians to Capt Thomas Hinckman

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Whereas John Tahawa-wan, John Sagamore, Great John, John a line and Little John, the chiefs, Sachems + Inhabitants of Weymesit, by a Deed of sale bearing date August the twenty sixth, six hundred fifty and five, did grant to Capt Thomas Hinckman of Chelmsford free liberty upon Weymesit Township aforesaid to cut firewood + Timber and free feed of his cattle, and said deed of Sale being acknowledged before Lawfull Authority of this Jurisdiction, v. entered in the County Records for Middlesex; and at the request of the Survivors + some of the Children of the aforesaid Indians, at a court at Weymesit upon the fourth day of the month May last past, held by Daniel Gookin Esq, Major General + his Associates, it was agreed between said Capt Hinckman, + ye Indians aforesaid, + ordered by said Court that Capt Hinckman should have a certaine parcel of Land set out to him for propriety, and so the said Hinckman should claim and all further right title, or Interest in any part of Weymesit Township besides what should be set

out to him for his full share of the whole. The Committee appointed by said Court were to agree with said Hinckman in reference to the Division aforesaid were John Thomas, Simon Bellisum, John Numphow + Joseph a line which Committee aforesaid with said Hinckman, and Jonathan Nanforth Senior Surveyor met upon ye ground on ye seventh day of the aforesaid Month of May, + did agree to begin at two little white oak plants standing on the South side a little Brook yt runs into Black Brook w^{ch} runs through Wancham sets old planting field; one of said white oaks are cratched, + stands near unto the lowest ford way over said little brook; and from said white oak plants ye line runs south four degrees + forty five minutes, East about three hundred paces by ye chain; w^{ch} closed at the south corner to said Hinckmans own Land, it is about six score feet wide at ye Northend from ye aforesaid white oak plants to ye said Hinckmans bounds, w^{ch} bounds this slip of Land (generally) on ye West. Also it was agreed that ye bounds of this Land from the aforesaid white oak plants sh^d be the running of ye water in said black brook until it passeth into Merimack. And it was at said Time Covenanted + agreed between ye aforesaid Indians + said Hinckman that all ye said Land contained within ye bounds aforesaid sh^d forever hereafter appertain + belong to said Hinckman to have + to hold to him ye said Thomas Hinckman (with all ye priviledges + appertinances to ye same appertaining or in anywise belonging) + to his Heires + Assignes forever to his + their only proper use + behoofe. And he ye said Thomas Hinckman for himselfe, his Heires Executors + Administrators (in consideration of ye Confirmation + Legal Enjoyment of said Tract of Land bounded as aforesaid) doe forever release + claim quit any further right title, or Interest in said Weymesit Township in reference to ye aforesaid claim, than what is set out to him

by bounds & measure as aforesaid in confirma-
 tion hereof the said John Thomas, Limon Bellicom
 John Nonphou, Joseph A-line (ye aforesaid Committee)
 together with other Indians at Weymesit inhabiting
 & consenting to said bargain on ye part of said
 Indians, And said Thomas Hinckman as fully & free-
 ly consenting therunto, have affixed their hands &
 seals herunto, the seventh day, aforesaid, of ye
 month of May in the year of our Lord God
 sixteen hundred eighty & six, & in ye second
 year of ye Reign of our Sovereign Lord King
 James ye second.

To all People to whom these
 presents shall come greeting. Know ye that
 Wamalanset (the only sonne surviving of old Pas-
 sachonaway deceased, who was the great & chiefe Sa-
 chem upon Merimack river). For ye in considera-
 tion of much Love & kindness together with many

gifts received for above Twenty years together at Wamalanset
 ready part of Cap^t Thomas Hinckman of Chelms-
 ford in ye County of Middlesex in the Colonie of
 ye Massachusetts in Newengland, and for that Cap^t Thomas
 Loxe & respect ye said Wamalanset still beareth to
 ye said Hinckman; the said Wamalanset hath given
 granted, aliene, enfeoffed & confirmed. And by these
 presents doe fully, freely, cleerly & absolutely give,
 grant, aliene enfeoffe & confirme to the said Thom-
 as Hinckman & to his Heires & Assignes forever
 one parcell of Land containing by Estimation thir-
 ty Acres be ye same more or less, situate &
 lying on ye South side of Merimack river afore-
 said, at a place commonly called Neahomkeak
 near Weymesit, it lieth upon a brook called
 Black brook, & is bounded by said Merimack ri-
 ver on ye North, by said Hinckman's owne Land
 on ye West it contains that whole Corne field
 fenced in with ditch otherwise y^t was broken up
 & improved for some years by said Sachem Wam-
 alanset & by his sonnes & by his men, it ly-
 ing near to ye old Indian fort in that
 place. To have & to hold the abovesaid field
 with all the priviledges & appurtenances to ye
 same appertaining or in anywise belonging, to
 him the said Thomas Hinckman & to his Heires &
 Assignes forever, to his & their only proper use
 & behoofe. And he said Wamalanset Sachem doe
 Covenant, promise & grant to & with said Thomas
 Hinckman & with his Heires & Assignes by these
 presents, that he said Wamalanset hath in himselfe
 good right, full power & Lawfull authority the
 promises to grant bargain & Confirme ye above
 granted & bargained premises to him said Thomas
 Hinckman & to his Heires & Assignes forever And
 that he said Thomas Hinckman, his Heires & Assignes
 forever shall & may at all times & from time
 to time forever hereafter assidly & peaceably have,
 hold, occupy, possess & enjoy the abovesaid premises
 & every part thereof without the Lawfull Let, hin-
 drance, contradiction or denyale of him said Wamalan-

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set, or of his sons, or of any of his
 men that had formerly interest therein, their
 heirs, Executors, Administrators, or Assignes, of them
 or of either or any of them, or of any
 other person or persons whatsoever Lawfully having
 & claiming any right, title, or interest therein or
 thereunto, by, from, or under them, or by any
 Lawfull wayes or means whatsoever In witness
 whereof said Wamalanet hath affixed his hand
 & seal, hereunto Always provided and it is
 hereby intended & concluded that in case said
 Wamalanet shall at any time in his lifetime
 have occasion for, or shall need for his own
 supply to improve any part of said land
 by planting, he shall have free Liberty so to
 doe, the premises notwithstanding. Dated November the
 eighteenth in the yeare of our Lord God one
 thousand six hundred eighty & five.

 Jonathan Tyng Esqr. of the Towne of Dunstable in
 the County of Middlesex in his Majties Territo-
 ry and Dominion of Newengland in America For
 & in consideration of the full and just summe
 of one hundred and fifty pound sterling New
 england Coyne to him w^{ch} and lawfully paid by
 Major Thomas Hinckman Esqrs John Fisk and Sergt
 Josiah Richardson all of the Towne of Chelmsford
 in the forenamed County in Newengland afores^d,
 w^{ch} mony so paid by them was for their own
 use and behoofe, as also for the use and be-
 behoofe of severall other Gentlemen and Neighbours
 hereafter mentioned in this Instrument The receipt
 of said hundred & fifty pound the said Jonathan
 Tyng doth by these presents acknowledge and those
 with do be fully satisfied, contented & paid, there-
 of & of every part & parcel thereof, doe fully
 freely, clearly & absolutely acquit, release & discharge
 the said Thomas Hinckman, J^{no} Fisk & Josiah Richardson
 they & every of them, their heirs, associates & assignes
 & every of them forever. Now granted, bargained &
 sold, aliened, enfeoffed & confirmed, & by these presents
 doe fully, freely, clearly and absolutely grant, barg-
 ained & sell, alien, enfeoffe & confirme unto the said
 Thomas Hinckman, John Fisk, Josiah Richardson sen^r,
 and to their associates W^m Moses Fisk of Branbury,
 W^m Thomas Clarke, Josiah Richardson Jun^r Jeremiah
 Rowers, James Richardson, Thomas Parker, Solomon Keyes Jun^r,
 Joseph Parker sen^r, Joseph Kido, Edward Spaldin sen^r,
